a school year

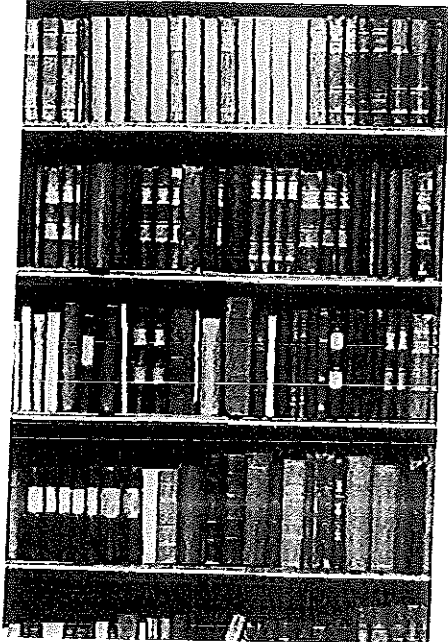
Student "B"

each day

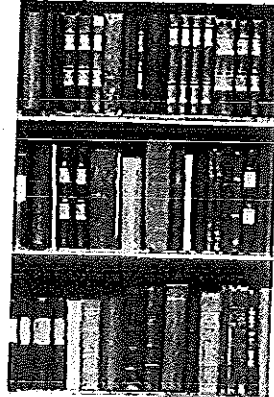
180 minutes in
